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Feedback on CSLB Inquiry on Requiring Reporting of Judgments

In last week's update, I reported that SB 465 (Hill), Chapter 372, Statutes of 2016, which took effect earlier this month is tasked with, among other things, to:

Require the CSLB to consult with licensees, consumers, and other interested stakeholders in order to prepare a study of judgments, arbitration awards, and settlements that were the result of claims for construction defects for rental residential units. By January 1, 2018 the CSLB is to report to the Legislature the results of this study to determine if the Board's ability to protect the public would be enhanced by regulations requiring licensees to report judgments, arbitration awards, or settlement payments of those claims.

In pursuit of accomplishing this task, the CSLB has reached out to the public et. al. to seek input on the question of whether there should be a mandate to require contractors to report all judgments, arbitration awards, or settlement payment of those claims and if so, starting at what amount?

The 'ink had hardly dried' on last week's update before I received the following thoughtful reply of concern from my good friend and colleague, Barney Kamine of the Kamine Construction Law Firm, which I have already forwarded to the CSLB:

"Unintended consequences department:

If Krs must report all construction defect settlements to CSLB AND IF THAT INFORMATION ROUTINELY BECOMES PUBLIC KNOWLEDGE, then fear of the damage public disclosure will have on Krs' business will discourage Krs from settling construction defect cases. THAT will severely harm consumers, who will have to take their cases to trial, instead of settling them, AND WORSE, since most construction defect cases are accepted by attorneys on a sliding scale contingency fee, consumers will have more trouble finding lawyers and will get less at the end than they would had they settled along the way. In sum, the proposal may cause more harm to consumers (and contractors) in the long run."

Democrats pave the way toward spending \$1 trillion on roads, ports and other projects

A lot more money could fuel improvements to California's highways, airports and rail lines under a 10-year, trillion-dollar infrastructure plan proposed Tuesday by Senate Democrats.

The ambitious but broad-stroke Democratic plan amounts to an opening bid, nudging the White House and congressional Republicans to start down the road toward a major infrastructure bill that California lawmakers would help write. "We must do it," Rep. John Garamendi, D-Walnut Grove, said in an interview Tuesday. "The question is, how do we pay for it?"

The Senate Democrats' plan asserts it can be paid for by "closing tax loopholes used by corporations and super wealthy individuals to offset associated costs," a notion that provokes deep skepticism among Republicans. California Gov. Jerry Brown has already identified \$59 billion in needed improvements and maintenance for the state's roads, highways and bridges. Garamendi on Tuesday promoted other projects that range from fixing Central Valley flood-control levees to deepening the Stockton and Sacramento ports.

"We have roads and tunnels and railroads and even a dam that the president could help us with," Brown said Tuesday in his State of the State speech, adding that "we can all work together, here in Sacramento and in Washington, as well."

President Donald Trump's team has compiled a list of about 50 infrastructure projects nationwide, totaling at least \$137.5 billion, as the new White House tries to determine its investment priorities, according to documents obtained by McClatchy's Kansas City Star and The Tacoma News Tribune. The documents, circulated within the congressional and business communities, offer a first glimpse at which projects around the country might get funding if Trump follows through on his campaign promise to renew America's crumbling highways, airports, dams and bridges.

Among the projects are three in California: the Cadiz water conveyance project proposed for the Mojave Desert, a Huntington Beach desalinization plant and the TransWest Express Transmission Project, an electric transmission system in Southern California, Nevada and Arizona.

Still other California infrastructure projects, from high-speed rail to the proposed WaterFix tunnels under the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, would incite far more controversy if proposed for inclusion. While Trump has lamented that "we have nothing" comparable to China's high-speed rail, for instance, House Republicans have sought to block California's project.

Many Republicans seem on board with the general idea of investing in infrastructure. House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy of Bakersfield has already identified it as one of the top priorities for the House of Representatives for the first 100 days of the new Congress, along with regulatory, tax and health care revisions.

"You've got to make sure that America has the infrastructure in the 21st century to be able to compete," McCarthy said Sunday on "The Cats Roundtable," a New York AM radio show.

Trump, too, touted during the campaign his intention to "transform America's crumbling infrastructure" and make "investments in transportation, clean water, a modern and reliable electricity grid," among other projects.

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Q: We are a Delaware Limited Liability Company (LLC) looking to obtain a California license. Being that we are not at all familiar with California's licensing requirements, we contacted our attorney for more information and he informed us that even if you hire somebody who has the requisite license (we are looking at the "B" General Building license), you have to go the Secretary of State and the State Licensing Board, and go through what sounds like a 6-8 month qualification program, which would include financial auditing of the company, before the State will recognize the license as being credited to the company. After further research, I found your website and just wanted to confirm my attorney is giving us correct information.

A: It is true that even if you have an employee who has the appropriate license, you will still register with the Secretary of State and apply with the Contractor's State License Board (CSLB). While it's possible for the licensing process to take 6-8 months for various reasons, the standard process usually takes closer to 2-3 months. Further, the CSLB does not perform any financial auditing of the company when you apply for a Contractor's License.

Q: In Nevada, my company holds an "A-17" (Lines to Transmit Electricity) license. What type of license is required for erecting cell towers in California?

A: The "A" or General Engineering classification would be the most appropriate license for installing cell towers in California.

Q: If my past customers like my work and refer me to one of their friends and I end up closing a sale, it appears that I can pay them a referral fee of let's say 500.00; because they are not under any licensing authority and not another contractor. I just want to make sure this is ok. While B&P Code Section 7157(d) clearly states that it is not legal for one contractor to pay any type of inducement (i.e. kickback) to another contractor, the law apparently does not include non-contractors.

A: You are correct that referral fees, sometimes called inducements or kickbacks, are not permitted from one contractor to another. However that being said #1, if you refer to the rest of Code Section 7157, specifically 7157(a), a contractor cannot give compensation or reward of any kind (except as referred to in subsection (b)) to an owner for referring sales involving Home Improvement Contracts.

#2, Subsection (b) allows a contractor or salesperson to give «tangible items to prospective customers for advertising or sales promotion purposes where the gift is not conditioned upon obtaining a contract for home improvement work if the gift does not exceed a value of five dollars (\$5) and only one such gift is given in connection with any single transaction." Therefore, the scenario you suggested in which you give your customers compensation of \$500 for referring your services is wrong and not permitted.

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

Safety Tip of the Week

ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION

An accident investigation is required whenever a serious incident happens on the job. The less time intervening between the accident and the investigation, the more accurate the in- formation that can be obtained. Facts are more accurate because people have not had time to become biased by the opinions of others, memories are clearer and more details are remembered.

Why do we investigate an accident? The reason is to obtain accurate information about what happened. What events led up to the accident; who was involved with the work; did anyone fail to follow procedures or did a piece of material or equipment fail? This information will be used to develop a conclusion regarding the physical cause of the accident.

Conditions at an accident scene are the only things that change faster than the opinions that evolve when there is a delay in compiling the facts. Much evidence is lost because it is removed from or altered at the accident site before any notice of it is taken or any record made. The contact phase of an accident is brief and initiates a wide spectrum of activity. People responding to an accident generally react rather than respond. Injured people are moved or removed for treatment. Equipment and other items are moved about to assist in the treatment of the injured party, and to provide passage or restore work. Prompt arrival at the scene allows the investigator to observe evidence before it has been removed or altered.

Since we all learn from accidents, the investigation will help us bring all the facts together, your input and involvement will help to assure that the necessary steps are taken to try to prevent a similar occurrence. All of us can learn from our mistakes. Make an effort to detect any existing hazards or improper procedures and report them to your foreman or supervisor immediately. Accidents are unplanned events, near misses let us know that there is a potential problem, and thorough accident investigations help us prevent recurrences.
