Sacramento is poised for a building boom. Now it just needs construction workers

Some young people should forget about packing boxes at an Amazon warehouse or going to college, construction leaders say. Instead, they should join the building trades.

The Sacramento region needs more than 7,000 workers annually in construction and related fields in the next four years – many of whom can make \$30 to \$40 an hour without a four-year college degree, according to a new report by Valley Vision and the Centers of Excellence at Los Rios Community College District.

The six-county area is short of about 2,000 carpenters, 600 electricians and 500 heavy equipment operators each year through 2021, the report says. Plumbers, painters and masonry workers are in short supply, too.

Part of the need stems from growth in the housing and commercial construction sectors, including big projects such as the redevelopment of Sacramento's historic downtown railyard. Aging and retiring workers are leaving an even larger gap.

Employers are having a tough time filling skilled positions, which generally require some advanced education along with on-the-job training. The shortage hurts the local economy and helps drive up housing prices by delaying development, researchers said.

Another major reason that the region is so "woefully undersupplied" in skilled construction workers, the report said, is that last decade's recession and housing collapse drove the majority of tradespeople out of the industry or forced them to leave the state to find work.

Many who remained now commute to the Bay Area for its significantly higher wages, despite the two-hour drive each way.

"We're recovering from a recession. We lost a lot of the workforce at that time. Now we've got projects ready to go and we have a (labor) pipeline shortage," said Trish Kelly, managing director at Valley Vision. The nonprofit focuses on improving the quality of life in the Sacramento region, including through research.

Building activity tends to come in waves in Sacramento, with recessions severely limiting it and housing booms greatly increasing it.

"When you have boom and bust cycles, it drives people away," Kelly said. "Obviously there's a lot of thought about how we build a longer-term pipeline and smooth out the cycles."

The labor shortage may actually help to extend the current recovery cycle by slowing the pace of construction, some experts said.

The rebuilding efforts in Napa and Sonoma counties, where forest fires destroyed thousands of homes and businesses last year, will likely pull away more local workers. Large-scale state infrastructure projects such as high-speed rail and highway upgrades could also draw on the local labor pool.

"One of our barriers to employment is that (Sacramento) wages haven't gone up enough to the point where a person says, 'It doesn't make sense to commute,' "said Rick Larkey, executive director of the North State Building Industry Foundation, a group that's been working with area high schools and builders to develop internship and training programs.

Part of the message to high school juniors and seniors – and to their parents – is that skilled trades are at least worth considering as alternatives to college and that a four-year degree isn't the guarantee of success it used to be.

"We've been able to demonstrate to parents and students and educators the value of trades," Larkey said.

Some things in law don't seem to make sense but it's how the rules are 'interpreted' that really matter to our first contractor. I will 'excel' as expert in offering not one, but two solutions for a contractor, then 'multiply' for another before 'adding' up our last answer...

Q: My company does a specialized type of work where we place hybrid fiber-coaxial ("HFC") systems underground. The underground placement will be 36" to 48" deep in the ground. We will not be connecting the HFC to the head end or central office so there is absolutely no low voltage electrical work involved by our company. The connection of the HFC to head end/central office is completed by a different company.

A: According to the CSLB, even though you are not electrifying the cabling, a "C-7" (Low Voltage) license would be needed to perform the work you described.

Q: I am going to be purchasing a Landscaping company and I need someone with a "C-27" license to act as my Qualifier. Is there a way to order a list of all Active (Landscaping) licenses in my area from the CSLB? I'm hoping they have it in an Excel format.

A: Yes, there are two ways to do this. The CSLB has a new feature on their website which allows you to search all contractors with a particular classification in a specific area/zip code. With this feature, you put in the city or area code you are interested in as well as the classification of licensee you are inquiring about. You will get a randomly generated list of contractors meeting your parameters. You can then choose the entire list or pick and choose contractors to make a smaller list, and then download it on to an Excel spreadsheet. The other option is to request the data from the CSLB with a Public Sales Custom Order form. This allows you further parameters, such as if you want all of Southern CA (as opposed to just one city/zip code), or if you only want Sole

Proprietors license information (as opposed to all business entities), etc. The CSLB will generate the data in the form of a CD/DVD, which can then be formatted in to an Excel spreadsheet. The downside to this second option is the CSLB charges a \$245.00 fee.

Q: We currently have a "C-8" (Glazing) contractor's license in the name of our corporation with a 'dba' (doing business as) name attached. We use this license for the installation of windows. Another side to our business manufactures and sells windows and doors, which doesn't require a contractor license. Can we operate under a different 'dba' name for the sales side of the business even though it's the same corporation?

A: Yes, a corporation can operate with *multiple* 'dba' names. You should check with your county to inquire about what registrations are required.

Q: I have a "C-7" (Low Voltage) license in CA and I need to obtain my NV Contractor's license. I found out electrical classifications are not reciprocal so I'm in the process of having my customers fill out the required references for me. The problem is my jobs are very sporadic. I haven't had continuous work over the last ten years, sometimes with several months in between each job. Is that going to be a problem?

A: No, it all adds up. Nevada requires that you have at least four years of full time work experience within the last ten years. Your experience does not have to be consecutive, but the dates on the references must cover a period of at least four years.


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
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Safety Tip of the Week

MOTOR VEHICLES

Ensure safe driving by including an inspection of any motor vehicle you drive, on or off the job. Check all lights, brake lights and turn signals; be sure that windshield wipers, the horn, and if applicable, the back-up warning device are in working order. Check the brakes, both the foot pedal as well as the hand brake. Check the status of the inspection sticker. Check the oil and make sure you have enough fuel. Report any defective or broken parts on company vehicles to your supervisor.

As the driver or operator you are responsible to make sure that all bins are closed, the load is secure, and the area is CLEAR before moving the vehicle. Extreme caution must be used when backing vehicles. Turn around instead of backing up whenever possible. If you must back-up and you have someone riding with you, have your passenger get out and direct you so you can back-up safely. When backing a vehicle in the vicinity of other workers or in a congested area, a signal person should always be used.

The operator must observe posted speed limits. Many accidents are caused by driving too slowly as well as too fast. Use turn signals when turning and when pulling out onto the road or highway. It is the responsibility of every employee who drives a company motor vehicle to be licensed, and to know and obey all state and local regulations pertaining to its operation.

Always carry your driver's license with you. Many states also require that the vehicle registration be carried in your car, van or truck. Every person who operates a motor vehicle has an obligation to themselves, their family, their employer, other drivers and pedestrians to operate their vehicle in a safe and courteous manner. Be a defensive driver! Make allowances for mistakes, lack of skill and lack of knowledge on the part of the other driver. Control your temper and be alert at all times, looking far enough ahead to recognize and avoid impending situations. You're in the driver's seat -- a lot rests on your shoulders. DRIVE DEFENSIVELY!
