Class B. This Type II New Juvenile Hall Project will replace the original late 1950's facility. The new facility will be constructed in phases with existing buildings being demolished to make way for the new recreation yard and support buildings. Upon completion, the facility will provide approximately 63,438 square feet (sf) of total building area and approximately 100,108 sf of site improvements on 9.217± acres of the greater 38.407± acres of county owned land in Salinas. The completed 120-bed facility will be laid out in a campus style design with a central 1-1/4 acre recreation yard surrounded by four housing buildings and support buildings. Two new 30-bed medium security housing buildings will be approximately 7,176 sf with single and double rooms, and the new 30-bed high-security housing building will be approximately 9,715 sf with single and double rooms. Each new housing building will have three 10-bed housing units with connecting dayroom and showers surrounding a central multi-purpose room, staff-support spaces, and an outdoor recreation area. Central control will have visual supervision of the housing units, attached outdoor exercise areas, and program spaces. Each new and existing housing unit will also be monitored by a smaller unit security station, located off the multi-purpose room.

You can be licensed and still not be able to use 'contractor' in your name! I will 'clarify' an answer for a "C-9". It's one for all and all for one in a Joint Venture and pay extra attention as we 'demolish' the question on RME's for another contractor...

Q: We have a Joint Venture (JV) license made up of three companies. We want to obtain another license number with a different business name, but with the same three entities. Will the CSLB allow the same Joint Venture partners to have two separate license numbers with different business names?

A: Yes, the CSLB allows for Joint Venture applicants to have two separate license numbers with two different business names even if they are made up of the same entities.

Q: We are a "C-21" (Building Moving/Demolition) Contractor and we recently hired an employee who previously had a license for the "A" (General Engineering), "B" (General Building), and "C-8" (Concrete) classifications. His license expired in 2014. We'd like to use him as a Responsible Managing Employee (RME) to add those classifications to our license. I assume we need to reactivate his license and then what paperwork would be required after that point?

A: In fact, you are not required to reactivate his license prior to adding him as the RME on your license for the three additional classifications. Actually, an RME is only permitted to be on one active license at a time, so if you were to reactivate his license and then apply for him to be added to your license as an RME, the CSLB would respond requesting that he Inactivate his license.

With regards to the required paperwork you would need to submit the Application for Additional Classification. Only one classification

can be requested a time, and an individual can only have one application in process at a time so you will need to complete three separate applications, and space them out accordingly.

Q: I applied for a "C-9" (drywall) license recently and the technician at the State who is handling my application contacted me and informed me that I cannot use the word "Contractor" in my business name. When I let her know I had already registered my business name with the CA Secretary of State and it was approved, she said I would need to come up with a DBA (Doing Business As) name. How is it my name is acceptable with the Secretary of State but not the CSLB?

A: There are many times when a business name is acceptable with the Secretary of State but not the CSLB, however I think there may have a been a bit of a misunderstanding in your case. Anyone applying for a Contractor's License can use the word "Contractor" in their business name provided it meets B&P Code Section 7059.1, which requires the name style to be in line with the classification you hold. If a word in your business name is vague, it needs to be clarified. For example, a drywall contractor cannot use the business name "ABC Contractor Inc.", but "ABC Contractor Inc. dba ABC Drywall Contractor" or simply "ABC Drywall Contractor" would be acceptable since you are describing the contracting work you are licensed to do.





Safety Tip of the Week

CONFINED SPACES

A 'confined or enclosed space' means any space having a limited means of access and egress, which is subject to the accumulation of toxic or flammable contaminants, has an oxygen deficient atmosphere, or could possibly cause suffocation due to entry of liquids, granulars, etc. or harm from corrosives, acids, etc.

Confined or enclosed spaces include but are not limited to storage tanks, process vessels, bins, boilers, ventilation or exhaust ducts, sewers, underground utility vaults, tunnels, pipelines, and open top spaces more than 4 feet in depth such as pits, tubs, vaults and vessels.

Caution is a must! Only fools will rush in and this means rescuers as well. If in doubt, check with your supervisor. Always be sure to follow the host employer's requirements. New OSHA rules require that the employer follow specific procedures before anyone enters a confined space.

The responsible host contractor or employer and your supervisor, using standard tests, must determine if ventilation or atmospheric conditions within the space are hazardous, and whether any special safety equipment is required such as protective clothing, respiratory equipment, etc. Once this has been done make sure that everyone going into the confined space is familiar with exactly what work is to be done. Everyone involved must know what to do should an emergency take place. In other words, be prepared for the unexpected! In addition. a competent attendant; trained in rescue procedures, C.P.R. and first aid must remain outside and stay in constant contact with those inside.

If the owner's policies and procedures concur with OSHA regulations, and we in turn follow these requirements, confined space work should be done accident free. Remember, confined spaces are dangerous. Look out for yourself as well as your co-workers. Before you jump in, check it out!

ALWAYS CHECK THE AIR INSIDE A VESSEL BEFORE YOU ENTER ONCE YOU'RE INSIDE IT'S TOO LATE! CHECK FOR OXYGEN CONTENT, FLAMMABILITY OR AN EXPLOSIVE ATMOSPHERE.
