

We 'fix up' an answer for a homeowner who plans on 'flipping out' in Newport Beach. Another contractor is 'generally' interested in replacing his RMO, without being put to the 'test' or disassociating his current Qualifier...

Q: I am 50% owner and President of a painting company. Our Responsible Managing Officer (RMO) is not disassociating but I would like to replace him nonetheless. I have been listed on the license since it was issued in 2009. I also have an Inactive "B" (General Building) license. I have never been the Qualifier for a "C-33" (Painting) license. Is an exam going to be required?

A: You can request a waiver of the trade exam based on the fact that you have been listed as an Officer on the license for over 5 years. Keep in mind that it's a request and not automatic, but as long as you can document the required experience, in most instances the waiver will be approved.

You can only have one Qualifier for each classification so if your RMO is not disassociating he will no longer be listed as an RMO, but he can still remain on the license as an Officer.

Q: I have worked for a General Building contractor here in Newport Beach for about 7 years but I don't have my own license. I am planning on buying a "fixer-upper" house and renovating it so that I can turn around and sell it. Do I need a license to do the remodel? I was hoping that I would qualify for the owner-builder exemption.

A: B&P Code section 7044 states that you cannot qualify for the owner builder exemption if the improvements are intended for the sale of the property. In order to self-perform the renovations I would suggest applying for your own license. The State requires that you document four years of experience and since you have worked for a General Contractor for 7 years, you will likely qualify for a contractor's license. If you need further help get back in touch.

Just FYI, seeing that you reside in Newport Beach, the CSLB just recently put out a News Release stating that home remodeling is booming in Orange County and, that in Costa Mesa, the amount of building permits pulled has increased 21% over the past three years.

That being said, the Newsletter went on to report that the CSLB teamed up with other local agencies in Orange County to conduct undercover stings and combat unlicensed activity. The CSLB issued citations to many unlicensed phony contractors for a range of criminal acts including unlicensed activity, illegal advertising, and several were also cited by Costa Mesa Code Enforcement for not having a city business license. Needless to say, it is risky business to do contracting work over \$500 without a license!

# Are you covering the cost of your Employee's Individual Medical Policy?

## Caution for Individual Policy Reimbursement

The IRS uses a FAQ on Employer Health Care Arrangements to highlight the potential liability for employers that, rather than establishing a group health plan, merely reimburse employees for the cost of their individual health plan premium.

**Q1. What are the consequences to the employer if the employer does not establish a health insurance plan for its own employees, but reimburses those employees for premiums they pay for health insurance (either through a qualified health plan in the Marketplace or outside the Marketplace)?**

The IRS makes it clear that the consequence is that the employer may face a penalty.

Specifically, as explained in [Notice 2013-54](#), employer reimbursement plans are considered to be group health plans and therefore subject to the market reforms, including the prohibition on annual limits for essential health benefits and the requirement to provide certain preventive care without cost sharing. Notice 2013-54 clarifies, however, that employer reimbursement plans cannot be integrated with individual policies to satisfy the market reforms.

Consequently, the employer may be subject to a \$100/day excise tax per applicable employee (which is \$36,500 per year, per employee) under [Code Sec. 4980 D](#).

For plan years beginning on and after January 1, 2014, employers should carefully evaluate arrangements under which they reimburse employees for premiums, or are otherwise involved in the purchase of individual health insurance policies that provide non-excepted medical coverage (i.e., coverage that is subject to health care reform's mandates) for employees. These arrangements create significant compliance concerns under health care reform. Furthermore, these individual policies should not be paid for or reimbursed on a pre-tax basis under an employer's cafeteria plan. As described in more detail (left).

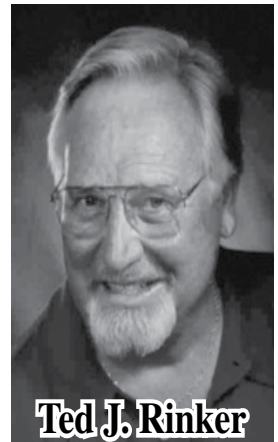

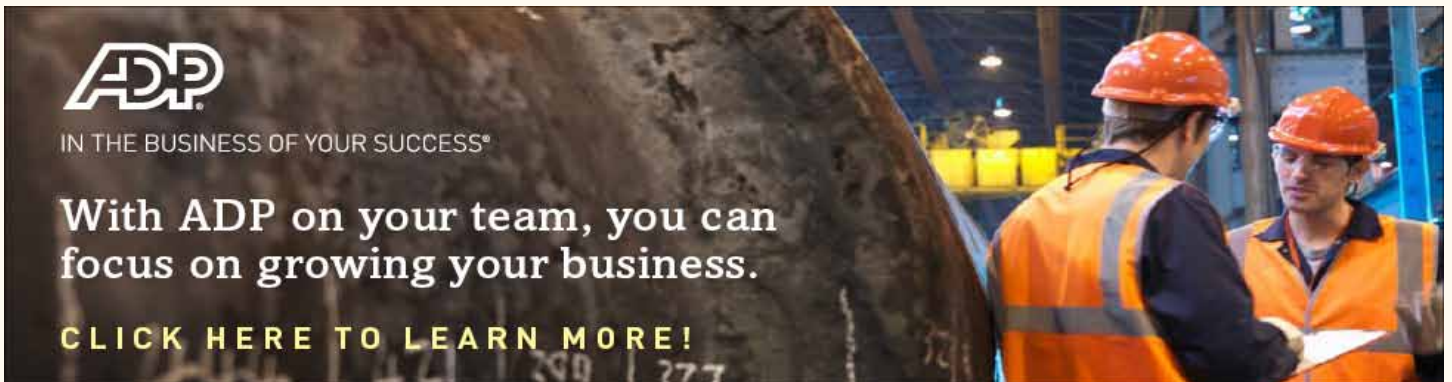

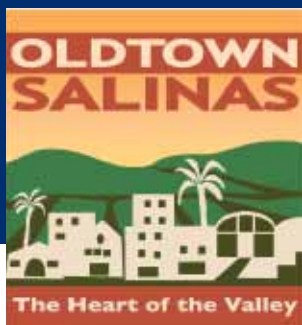

# Safety Tip of the Week

## HEAVY EQUIPMENT

Heavy equipment is just what it says it is - 'HEAVY'. These large and powerful machines can be dangerous to those that work around them as well as those who operate them. The first thing that we need to recognize is that the operator has a limited sight range and blind spots as well. NEVER assume that the operator can see you!

All bi-directional earth moving equipment that has the rear view obstructed must have a backup alarm. This alarm is an audible device that emits a warning sound to let you know that the piece of equipment is backing up. ALWAYS observe this warning -- look up from what you are doing and make sure you are out of the way. It is often difficult to hear the backup alarm on noisy construction sites, so if you're working nearby, be cautious and extra alert for the sound of the alarm. Other types of heavy equipment are equipped with a horn similar to the one that you have in your car. The operator may sound the horn to warn you or to get your attention to let you know that he is about to swing something around or over you.

Keep a keen eye out for the movement of equipment, especially around pinch points. These areas should be barricaded off to limit access so no one gets crushed when a crane swings around.

If you are the operator of heavy equipment, ALWAYS check the brakes, steering, backup alarm, headlights and other controls before starting. Don't forget to wear your personal protective equipment. Eye protection, safety boots, hard hat or hearing protection may be required by your employer. If it's required be sure to wear it.

Another area of concern is those who try to hitch a ride on a piece of equipment. This is absolutely forbidden! To do so will cause an accident should the rider fall off. A good rule to follow is 'NO PASSENGERS ALLOWED' under ANY circumstances.

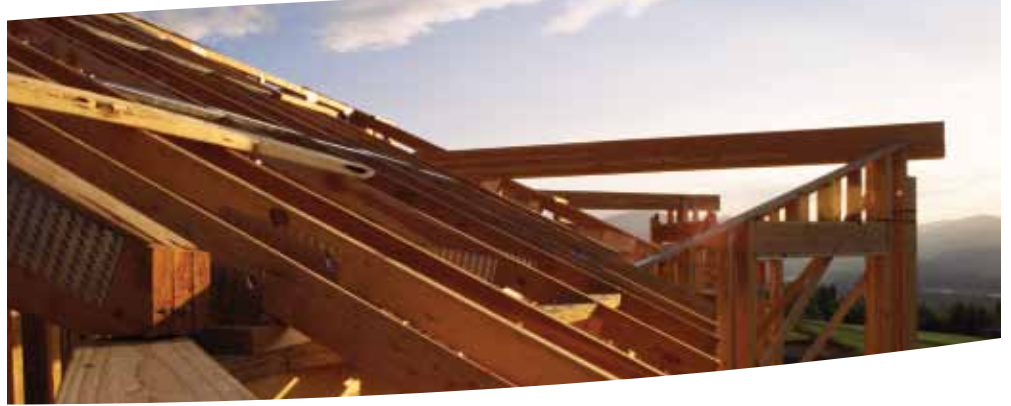

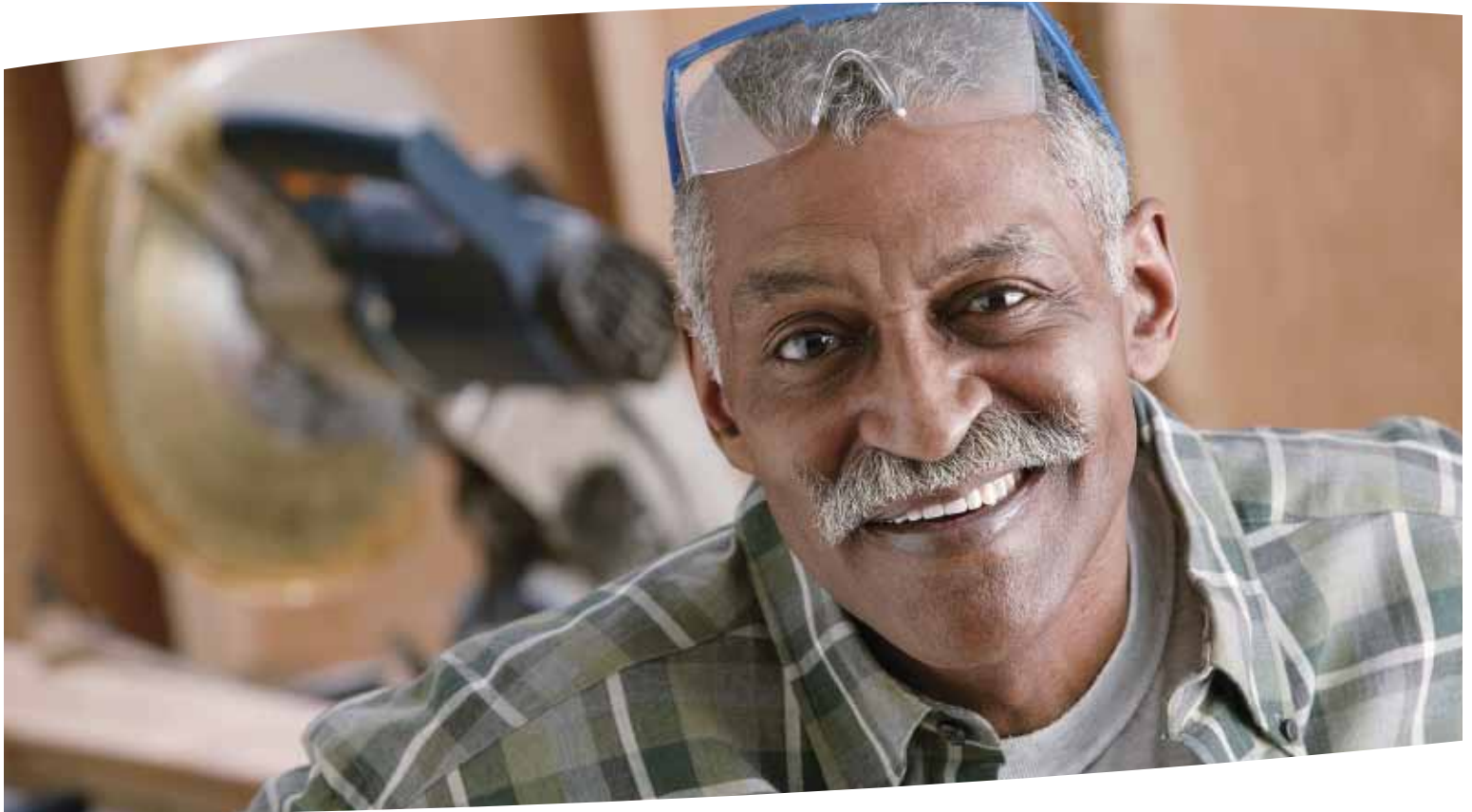
