

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

What can you do in Arizona that you can't do here? We also help contractors with questions on LLC and foreign corporations, and we 'raise' the spirits of a Nevada company looking for work in California...

Q: I have worked as a journeyman handyman/contractor for almost a year in California and I just recently moved to Arizona. I have done renovations and repairs on my own house over the years and then started my own handyman business almost a year ago. I want to obtain a contractor's license in Arizona so that I can do bigger projects but I don't have the four years of full-time work experience. What can a person do if they need a license to do work but they don't have the experience? Is there a type of license I can get to gain the experience in order to eventually obtain the broader General Building ("B") license?

A: Yes there is! While you're correct that the "B" license requires four years of experience, Arizona has many specialty classifications that do not require that you document four years of experience. For example, the flooring ("CR-8") license requires three years of experience, and the Painting ("CR-34") license only requires two years of experience. In your case, you may be interested in the Minor Home Improvements ("R-62") license that doesn't require any experience at all! The "R-62" allows you to do remodeling, repairs and improvements not exceeding \$5000. No structural work can be performed. Electrical, Plumbing, AC, Heating, Boilers, and Roofing must be performed by appropriately licensed contractors. Let us know if we can help as we work in Arizona, Nevada and California regularly.

Q: You helped me in the past with my previous company I did consulting work for. I've joined another company on a full time basis now. We're contemplating setting up a subsidiary for which we will need to obtain new contractor licenses. I know that there's some additional cost/complexity for using Limited Liability Company (LLC), but I was wondering if there was any benefit/detriment related to using a California corporation as opposed to a Delaware corporation.

A: That would be something that you would want to consult an attorney or your accountant about. With regards to the CSLB and the licensing process, the difference between applying as a California corporation vs. a Delaware corporation would be the personnel listed on the application. Foreign corporations are required to list only their President and Qualifying Individual on the application, while California corporations must list their President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Qualifying Individual on the application.

Q: I am a crane and rigging contractor in Nevada. Here it's a "C-14i" classification and there was only a Business exam that was required. One of my customers is requesting my services in California so I need to get licensed. I checked a couple of competitor's licenses in CA and they both have an "A" (General Engineering) license. Is that required to perform crane and rigging services in California? I'm worried that I would not be able to pass the trade exam since I have no knowledge of Engineering outside of the crane business I've run for the last 10 years.

A: While a General Engineering contractor can operate cranes and material hoisting equipment, the "A" license is not required in your case.

The "C-61"/"D-21" (Machinery and Pumps) classification allows you to install, remove, modify or repair pumps; conveyer; cranes; dock levelers; various hoisting and material handling equipment.

# Are you covering the cost of your Employee's Individual Medical Policy?

## **Caution for Individual Policy Reimbursement**

The IRS uses a FAQ on Employer Health Care Arrangements to highlight the potential liability for employers that, rather than establishing a group health plan, merely reimburse employees for the cost of their individual health plan premium.

**Q1. What are the consequences to the employer if the employer does not establish a health insurance plan for its own employees, but reimburses those employees for premiums they pay for health insurance (either through a qualified health plan in the Marketplace or outside the Marketplace)?**

The IRS makes it clear that the consequence is that the employer may face a penalty.

Specifically, as explained in [Notice 2013-54](#), employer reimbursement plans are considered to be group health plans and therefore subject to the market reforms, including the prohibition on annual limits for essential health benefits and the requirement to provide certain preventive care without cost sharing. Notice 2013-54 clarifies, however, that employer reimbursement plans cannot be integrated with individual policies to satisfy the market reforms.

Consequently, the employer may be subject to a \$100/day excise tax per applicable employee (which is \$36,500 per year, per employee) under [Code Sec. 4980 D](#).

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For plan years beginning on and after January 1, 2014, employers should carefully evaluate arrangements under which they reimburse employees for premiums, or are otherwise involved in the purchase of individual health insurance policies that provide non-excepted medical coverage (i.e., coverage that is subject to health care reform's mandates) for employees. These arrangements create significant compliance concerns under health care reform. Furthermore, these individual policies should not be paid for or reimbursed on a pre-tax basis under an employer's cafeteria plan. As described in more detail (left).

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



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

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# Safety Tip of the Week

## Asphalt

Asphalt is a black, sticky material that comes from crude oil. It is used in paving, roofing, waterproofing and some glues. Asphalt is often confused with coal tar or pitch. Coal tar and pitch come from coal, not oil. Asphalt is a solid or semisolid substance. It is mixed with solvents to make it more liquid, and easier to work with. Some of the solvents used to mix with asphalt are naphtha, toluene, and xylene. These solvents are hazardous substances, flammable, very smelly and increase the potential hazards of working with asphalt. There are many different types and grades of asphalt in current use.

Who is at risk? It is estimated that 350,000 workers are exposed to asphalt fumes each year. Workers most likely to be exposed to asphalt fumes are road workers, roofers, employees at hot-mix asphalt facilities and general construction workers.

### Health Dangers

Breathing asphalt fumes is the most common method of exposure. The acute (immediate) health effects of asphalt fumes include; headache, skin rash, fatigue, eye and throat irritation, and cough. Exposure to asphalt fumes (and the solvents in them) over long periods of time (chronic exposure) may cause lung and stomach cancer. Long-term contact of asphalt with your skin can cause pigment change, which is made worse by sunlight exposure. To find out the specific hazards associated with the type of asphalt you are working with, consult the Material Safety Data Sheet from your employer.

Many forms of asphalt are flammable. This can lead to potential fires and explosions. Sources of ignition (e.g. sparks, flames, cigarettes, etc.) should be kept away from the area where the hot asphalt is being used. Asphalt is almost always used hot, so burns are a common form of injuries. Have a fire extinguisher available, of the correct type, for possible fires. Do not use a fire extinguisher unless you have been fully trained in its use.

### Methods of Control

**Substitution** – there are many types of asphalt. Some are more hazardous than others. If possible, substitute a less hazardous form of asphalt in your construction project.

**Isolation** – isolating asphalt operations will minimize worker exposure. Where possible, transfer the asphalt automatically by pump to minimize exposures.

**Enclosure** – enclose the mixing and stirring operations. Stirring asphalt in an open kettle exposes you to fumes, solvent vapors and possible burns.

Prior to starting any job, discuss with your supervisor/employer the appropriate personal protective equipment necessary for the work being performed.

- Gloves – for the best protection, use thermally insulated gloves.
- Clothes – wear long sleeve shirts and long pants.
- Eye protection – wear indirect vent goggles when working with liquids. If the liquids are corrosive, highly irritating or toxic, wear a face shield along with the goggles.

### Safe Work Practices

- Do not eat, smoke or drink where asphalt is handled.
- Wash hands carefully before eating, drinking, smoking or using the toilet.
- If you feel ill while working with asphalt, let your supervisor know right away.
