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**CA Legislature Passes Gov. Brown's \$52b Plan To Fix Roads, Hike Gas Taxes**

The California Legislature has approved Gov. Jerry Brown's \$52 billion plan to fix the state's roads through an increase in gas taxes and other vehicle fees. The governor's 10-year plan calls for raising gasoline excise taxes by 12 cents a gallon. It would also increase vehicle registration fees and impose a \$100 charge on emission-free vehicles. Brown has said the increase would equal less than \$10 a month for most drivers.

The Democratic governor has said California has \$59 billion in deferred maintenance on state highways and \$78 billion on local streets and roads. Last month he suggested tax increases may be required to address the problem.

The proposal was designed to fix potholes and repair bridges, but also provide funds for public transit and biking and walking trails.

Gas taxes will increase this year after the Legislature approved a \$52 billion plan to fix California's roads. Here's where the money would come from:

- \$24.4 billion by raising the gasoline excise taxes 12 cents per gallon, or 43 percent above the current rate of 27.8 cents.
- \$7.3 billion by raising the current 16-cent-a-gallon diesel excise tax by 20 cents - a 125 percent increase.
- \$3.5 billion by increasing the state diesel sales tax from 9 percent to 13 percent.
- \$16.3 billion from an annual transportation improvement fee based on a vehicle's value, similar to what owners already pay annually to the state Department of Motor Vehicles. The fees range from \$25 for vehicles valued at less than \$5,000 to \$175 for vehicles topping \$60,000. The administration says nearly nine-in-10 vehicles would be assessed a fee of \$50 or less.
- \$200 million from a new \$100 annual fee, starting in 2020, on zero-emission vehicles.
- \$706 million in repayments of transportation funds that had previously been loaned to the state's General Fund.

The money would be split between state and local governments. Here's where it would go:

- The local share includes \$15 billion to fix potholes, \$7.5 billion for public transportation and \$1 billion for walking and biking trails.
- The state share includes \$15 billion for highway repairs, \$4 billion for bridge and culvert repairs, \$2.5 billion to reduce traffic on major commuter routes.

**The U.S. District Court in Los Angeles has struck down AB 219 as unconstitutional *once again*.**

AB 219 took effect on July 1, 2016. It applied California prevailing wage requirements to the delivery of ready-mix concrete to public works. This was big news for two reasons: (1) it hit the ready-mix concrete industry—and all of the businesses that depend on it—very hard; and (2) it represents the *first time* that prevailing wage requirements have been imposed on material suppliers (as opposed to on-site contractors).

On June 30, 2016—the day before AB 219 took effect—eight ready-mix companies filed a lawsuit in federal court challenging the constitutionality of the new statute on Equal Protection grounds. In essence, they argued it was unfair to single out ready-mix concrete companies for special treatment, leaving all other material suppliers unaffected.

# California Lawmakers Aim to Implement Overtime Rule Despite Federal Delay

**L**awmakers in California have proposed legislation to increase the salary threshold for employees who are exempt from overtime pay to \$47,476—the same threshold that was blocked last year at the federal level (</resourcesandtools/legal-and-compliance/employment-law/pages/flsa-overtime-rule-resources.aspx>).

California's exempt salary threshold is calculated by doubling the minimum wage, so it increases with every minimum wage hike. Currently, businesses with 26 or more employees must:

- Pay nonexempt workers at least \$10.50 an hour.
- Pay exempt executive, administrative and professional workers at least \$3,640 per month (\$43,680 annualized).

Employers with 25 or fewer workers must:

- Pay nonexempt workers at least \$10 an hour.
- Pay exempt executive, administrative and professional workers at least \$3,467 per month (\$41,600 annualized).

A.B. 1565 ([www.shrm.orghttp://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/billNavClient.xhtml?bill\\_id=201720180AB1565](http://www.shrm.orghttp://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/billNavClient.xhtml?bill_id=201720180AB1565)) would increase the exempt salary threshold to the greater of \$3,956 per month (\$47,476 annualized) or double the minimum wage, explained Michael Kalt, an attorney with Wilson Turner Kosmo in San Diego.

The proposed legislation presumably would take effect on Jan. 1, 2018, if enacted, he said. "It is presently scheduled to be heard in the Assembly's Labor and Employment Committee on April 19, so we will get an early test of its likelihood of passage."

Employers may be wondering what the reasoning is behind the proposed legislation, especially since the state's exempt salary threshold is already scheduled to exceed \$47,476 for all employers by 2020.

"It is more symbolic than anything," said James McDonald Jr., an attorney with Fisher Phillips in Irvine, Calif. "California's Legislature is so opposed to the current administration in Washington that it will likely try to put back for employees whatever the federal government takes away."

## Planned Minimum Wage Increases

The state minimum wage and exempt salary threshold are scheduled to rise incrementally over the next few years as follows for businesses with at least 26 employees (smaller employers have an extra year to comply with each increase):

2018	\$11	\$880	\$3,813.33	\$45,760

In its current form, A.B. 1565 doesn't distinguish between large and small employers. If enacted, it would raise the exempt salary threshold to meet the now-blocked federal overtime rule one year before it was set to go beyond it for larger employers and two years early for smaller employers in California, Kalt explained.

#### **New Law, Same Analysis**

If the proposed legislation is approved, employers will essentially have to go through the same analysis as they did in 2016 when they thought the federal threshold would be raised, Kalt said.

"Just as when the U.S. Department of Labor proposed such an increased salary threshold, if this legislation passes employers will need to consider how to treat those employees being paid a monthly salary between the current threshold and the new \$3,956 minimum," McDonald said. "If they are switched to hourly pay and they work considerable overtime, it may be less expensive simply to raise their salary to the new minimum."

He added that controls would have to be in place for employees who are paid on an hourly basis to ensure that they do not work unauthorized overtime.

"But such limits might make it difficult for them to get the job done," he said. "It will require a job-by-job analysis."

It's important to note that a higher salary threshold may not result in a raise for exempt employees who are currently earning below the proposed minimum.

"Some employers will not be able to afford paying a higher salary and may simply eliminate the position or reduce the number of positions available," McDonald said. "This in turn will limit career opportunities for those looking for entry-level management jobs."

Kalt said he thinks the bill will pass the Legislature, but Gov. Jerry Brown could veto it.

The minimum wage was just raised with a two-tier system that takes small businesses into account, he said. If this is enacted, all employers would have to reach a higher standard in less time and Brown could say that's too much, too soon, he added.

Democrats have a supermajority in both chambers of the state Legislature, so that means they could override a veto. This would be a big test to see how pro-business Democrats react, Kalt said.



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Bonds, license bonds that is, employee ownership and help for a 'foreigner' are introduced in this edition. I start with some important differences as an applicant gets his business organized along some 'easy' lines...

Q: I am going to be buying an HVAC company and obtaining a new Contractor's License. I am trying to decide whether I should apply as a corporation or an LLC. What is the difference and is one easier than the other when it comes to getting licensed?

A: There are several differences between corporations and LLC's (Limited Liability Company), the biggest difference being how each are taxed. You should consult with an attorney or tax advisor to discuss the tax differences and advantages/disadvantages of each.

Choosing one type of entity is not necessarily "easier" than the other when it comes to getting licensed, there are several additional requirements for Contractors applying as an LLC. In addition to the \$15,000 Contractors Bond that is required of all licensees, LLC's are required to also have a \$100,000 LLC/Worker Bond. Limited Liability Companies are also required to show proof of at least \$1 million in General Liability coverage, which is not required for other entities.

Q: We are in the process of replacing our RME (Responsible Managing Employee) who recently left the company. When we originally obtained the license, we posted \$12,500 cash in lieu of the \$12,500 Bond of Qualified Individual. Is that money transferrable to the new RME? If it's not transferrable, how do we go about getting the money back so that we can use it for the new Qualifier?

A: Bonds, including cash bonds, are not transferrable. You will either need to post a \$12,500 Bond of Qualified Individual or post another \$12,500 cash. The CSLB will not release the cash bond until

three years after the period for which it provided coverage. Cash deposits are held in case a claim is filed against the deposit.

Q: When applying for a license as a corporation, are we required to list our shareholder (which is another corporation) on the application, or are Directors sufficient?

A: If you are applying as a Foreign corporation (entity formed outside of California) you are required to at a minimum list your President on the application. If you are applying as a Domestic Corporation, you are required to list your President, Secretary, and Treasurer on the application. The CSLB does not require that corporations list their shareholders.

Q: Our corporation is a licensed contractor in Nevada. We are in the process of changing from a standard 'S' Corporation to an Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP). Do we need to do anything to update our Contractor's License?

A: A change in ownership does not require that you update your Nevada Contractors License. However, I am not a tax advisor or attorney so suggest you research changing from an 'S' Corporation to an ESOP and if it would warrant a new Federal Identification number. That change may trigger a new application be submitted as your 'business entity' is now a different structure.

If your entity changes or if your Officers change, you are required to report it to the Nevada Contractors Board to update your license.

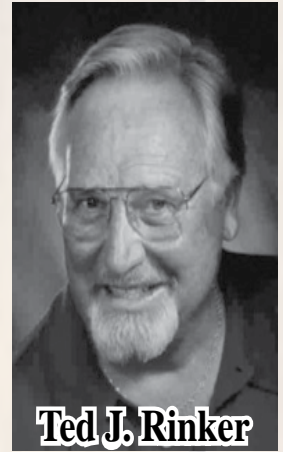

# Safety Tip of the Week

## PRECAUTIONS TO BE OBSERVED DURING ELECTRICAL TESTING

Prior to conducting functional tests or energizing circuits, the necessary precautions shall be taken to assure that the tests can be conducted without injuring personnel or causing damage to equipment or materials.

The following guidelines shall be observed by personnel assigned to test activities:

Other contractors, client personnel and company personnel working in an area which could be effected by a test shall be made aware of the scheduled test. The Test Supervisor or his designee shall be responsible for this notification and shall document the action in his daily log or by other suitable means.

Barricades and/or guards shall be posted as required to protect personnel from moving items, high-voltage or other potential danger.

Test Supervisors shall determine the panels, boxes or other equipment which will be energized during the test.

Personnel shall be assigned and thoroughly indoctrinated as to the methods to be used to terminate the test in case of an emergency.

Parallel and interconnecting circuits shall be locked-out to prevent energization. Tags shall be placed on switches or equipment to indicate that such circuits are not to be energized.

Energized equipment or circuits shall be tagged showing that they are energized. The tags shall not be removed until the test is complete and the item or area is placed in a safe condition.

Tests shall be conducted or supervised by qualified personnel

Observe all the safety precautions which are contained in the test procedure applicable to the item or system being tested.

Safety equipment (e.g., rubber gloves, eye protection, grounding sticks, etc.) shall be used by test personnel as applicable.

On completion of tests, the Test Supervisor shall assure that equipment or circuits are de-energized and discharged, prior to terminating the test activity.
