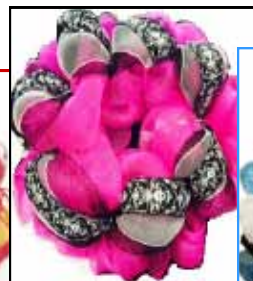

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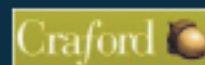

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Attending conferences, CSLB Board meetings and other events important to contractors is part of my job. For many contractors seeking contracts and new bid opportunity also takes them out 'on the road'...

Q: We are a CA "B" General Building contracting company and are applying for a new license in the State of Nevada. We typically do smaller remodeling jobs; we don't build new homes or buildings. We submitted our application and requested a bid limit of \$50,000. The Nevada Board sent a letter stating that as "B" contractors we are required to request at least a \$200,000 bid limit, and further stated that our financial statement must "support" that bid limit request.

We don't need a bid limit that high, nor are we sure that our financials "support" a limit that high. My boss suggested I contact you to see if you know of any way around this requirement. Just to throw in another wrench, we need this license in a hurry and we don't have time to wait for our accountant to prepare a new financial statement!

A: There is no way around the bid limit requirement for "B" contractors, nor is there any way around the requirement that you must be able to show some equity to support your requested limit. The Nevada Board assumes that most "B" contractors are doing ground-up construction and therefore the majority of their jobs will go over \$200,000.

Q: I represent a construction company Incorporated in Delaware. They are planning on conducting business in Los Angeles but do not have a CA contractor's license. My client would like to know if in place of taking the law and general building exams, he can associate or Joint Venture with an established company that possesses a General contractor's license?

A: Your client may only "Joint Venture" with an established company if they themselves have a CA contractor's license. By definition, a Joint Venture (JV) consists of two or more entities that are licensed, active and in good standing. This would mean having someone qualify a license for the out-of-state company by taking the law and trade exams. If you go through this process, there would be no need for the JV.

Q: I would like more information on getting my Nevada state contractor's license for remodeling homes. Other than passing the exams, what obstacles am I likely to encounter during this process.

A: The Nevada license application runs 20+ pages. Among the requirements are securing a statement from your bank; providing a detailed financial statement (or one compiled by your CPA); and getting 4 notarized references that attest to your 4 plus years experience in the building trades. Once the application is submitted and reviewed, the State Board will notify you regarding their testing requirements. After you pass both the business management and trade exams, the Board will notify you regarding the contractors' bond amount. This bond is on a sliding scale and is tied to the bid limit you list on your application.

Caution for Individual Policy Reimbursement

The IRS uses a FAQ on Employer Health Care Arrangements to highlight the potential liability for employers that, rather than establishing a group health plan, merely reimburse employees for the cost of their individual health plan premium.

Q1. What are the consequences to the employer if the employer does not establish a health insurance plan for its own employees, but reimburses those employees for premiums they pay for health insurance (either through a qualified health plan in the Marketplace or outside the Marketplace)?

The IRS makes it clear that the consequence is that the employer may face a penalty.

Specifically, as explained in [Notice 2013-54](#), employer reimbursement plans are considered to be group health plans and therefore subject to the market reforms, including the prohibition on annual limits for essential health benefits and the requirement to provide certain preventive care without cost sharing. Notice 2013-54 clarifies, however, that employer reimbursement plans cannot be integrated with individual policies to satisfy the market reforms.

Consequently, the employer may be subject to a \$100/day excise tax per applicable employee (which is \$36,500 per year, per employee) under [Code Sec. 4980 D](#).

For plan years beginning on and after January 1, 2014, employers should carefully evaluate arrangements under which they reimburse employees for premiums, or are otherwise involved in the purchase of individual health insurance policies that provide non-excepted medical coverage (i.e., coverage that is subject to health care reform's mandates) for employees. These arrangements create significant compliance concerns under health care reform. Furthermore, these individual policies should not be paid for or reimbursed on a pre-tax basis under an employer's cafeteria plan. As described in more detail (left).

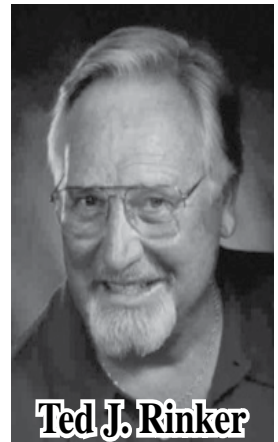
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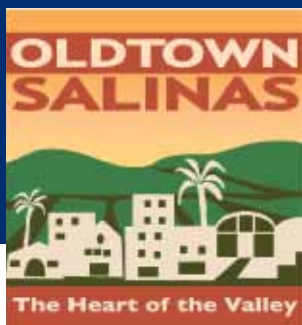

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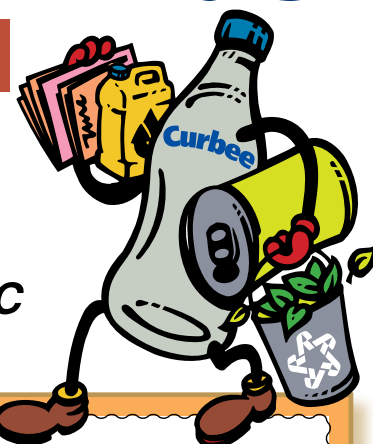

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Safety Tip of the Week

SAWS

This week's safety message covers Band, Portable Circular, Radial, and Table Saws. All four saws are used in construction. Each has a different use but all are capable of causing a serious injury if not used properly. Following are various OSHA guidelines pertaining to these saws:

Band Saws - All portions of band saw blades shall be enclosed or guarded, except for the working portion of the blade between the bottom of the guide rolls and the table. Band saw wheels shall be fully encased.

Portable Circular Saws - Portable, power-driven circular saws shall be equipped with guards above and below the base plate or shoe. The lower guard shall cover the saw to the depth of the teeth, except for the minimum arc required to allow proper retraction and contact with the work, and shall automatically return to the covering position when the blade is removed from the work.

Radial Saws - Radial saws shall have an upper guard that completely encloses the upper half of the saw blade. The sides of the lower exposed portion of the blade shall be guarded by a device that will automatically adjust to the thickness of and remain in contact with the material being cut. Radial saws used for ripping shall have non kick back fingers or dogs. Radial saws shall be installed so that the cutting head will return to the starting position when released by the operator.

Saws - Circular table saws shall have a hood over the portion of the saw above the table, mounted so that the will automatically adjust itself to the thickness of and remain in contact with the material being cut. Circular table saws shall have a spreader aligned with the blade, spaced no more than 1/2 inch behind the largest blade mounted in the saw. This provision does not apply when grooving, dadoing, or rabbeting. Circular table saws used for ripping shall have non kick back fingers or dogs. Feeder attachments shall have the feed rolls or other moving parts covered or guarded so as to protect the operator from hazardous points.

Follow these rules. If you have a question about any one of these saws, ask your supervisor before you use it!

A moving saw blade can sever a finger or hand in a split second! Never remove a guard or wedge one open.

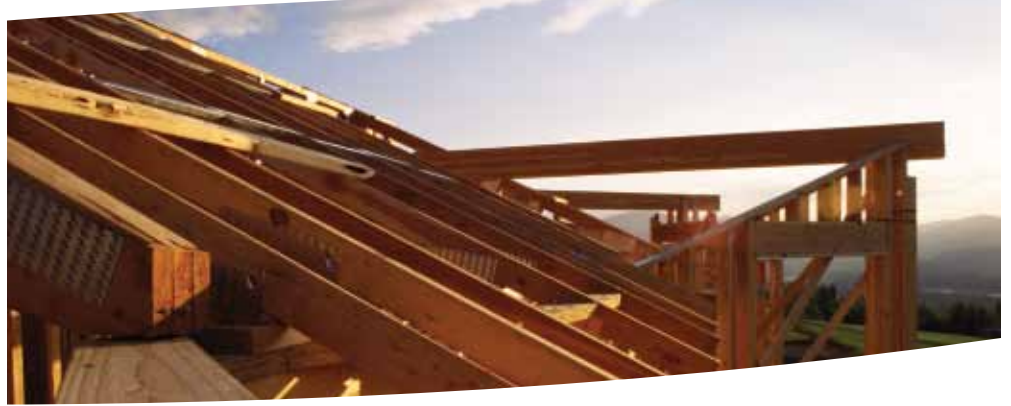

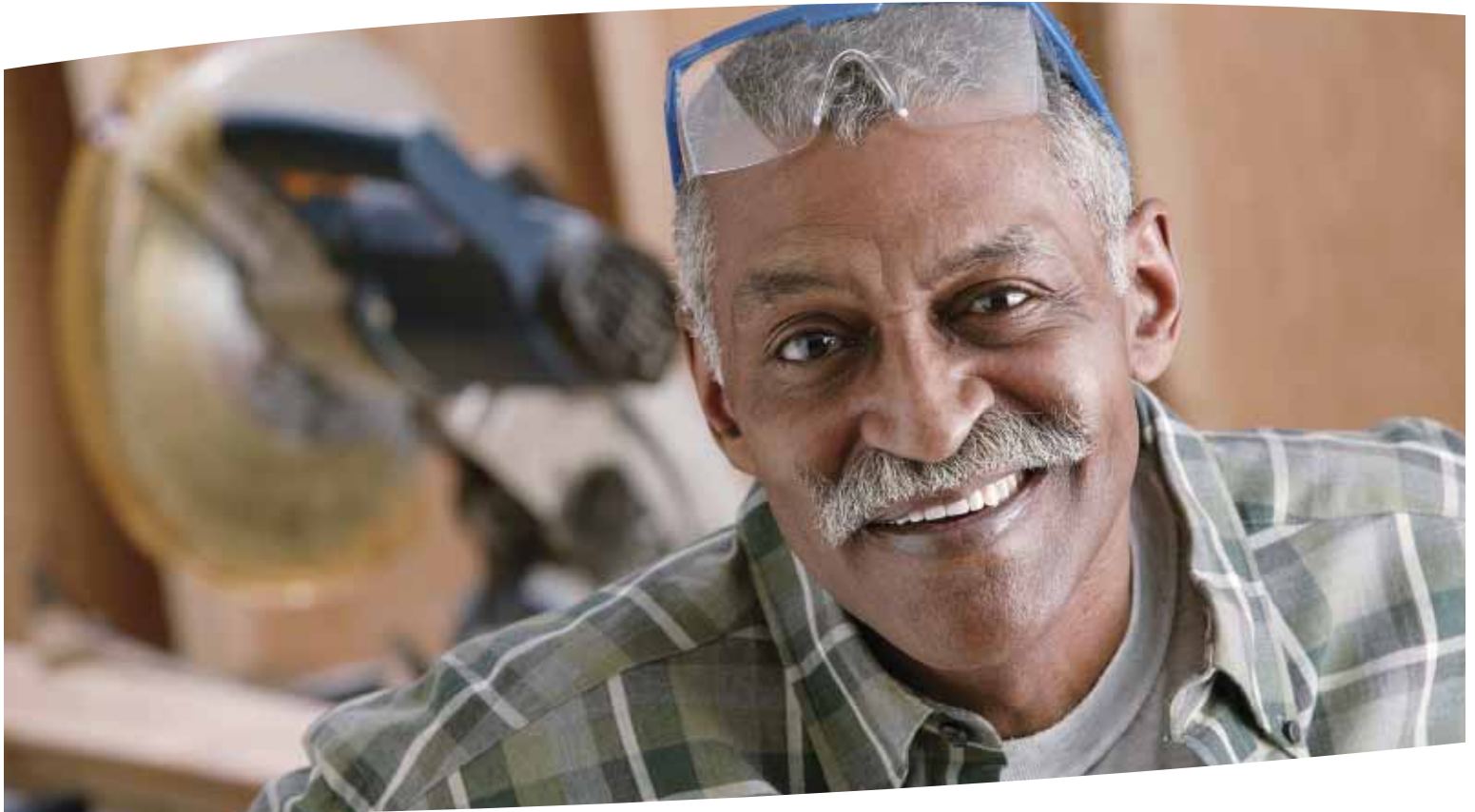
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
