Cal/OSHA Reminds Employers with Outdoor Workers to Protect Them from Heat Illness

Cal/OSHA is reminding all employers to protect their outdoor workers from heat illness, especially those not accustomed to working in high heat conditions

Employers need to ensure workers are drinking plenty of water and taking breaks in the shade considering the heat across many regions of California. The National Weather Service is forecasting unusually high temperatures throughout the state, which will remain high for the rest of this week. Special attention must be given to new employees who have not been acclimatized to working under hot conditions, as they are particularly vulnerable to heat illness, Cal/OSHA states. The new employees must be monitored carefully for signs of heat illness and should, if possible, be allowed to begin work earlier in the day when the temperature is lower or gradually work up to a full schedule. Many regions of the state will be reaching temperatures in the triple digits. When temperatures reach 95 degrees or above, employers are required to implement high heat procedures to ensure outdoor workers are protected. Procedures include effective monitoring of all workers through methods such as a mandatory buddy system for workers or regular communication with workers who work alone. California's Heat Illness Prevention Standard requires employers to train workers on the signs and symptoms of heat illness, provide shade when temperatures exceed 80 degrees, develop emergency response procedures and train workers on how to execute those procedures when necessary. Cal/OSHA inspects outdoor worksites in agriculture, construction, landscaping, and other operations throughout the heat season.

Cal/OSHA's Heat Illness Prevention program, the first of its kind in the nation, includes enforcement of heat regulations as well as multilingual outreach and training for California's employers and workers. Online information on heat illness prevention requirements and training materials are available on Cal/OSHA's Heat Illness Prevention web page or the Water. Rest. Shade. Campaign site. A Heat Illness Prevention e-tool also is available on the Cal/OSHA website.

The Cal/OSHA Consultation Services branch provides free and voluntary assistance to employers to improve their safety and health programs. Employers should call (800) 963-9424 for assistance from Cal/OSHA Consultation Services.

AB 45 California School Employee Housing Assistance Grant Program

AB 45 (Thurmond D) would create the *California School Employee Housing Assistance Grant Program*, a pre-development grant and loan program to fund the creation of affordable housing for school district employees, including teachers. Sounds great right? Not so fast. Thurmond inserted a requirement that any project funded by a pre-development grant is subject to a project labor agreement and is either a public work or is subject to a legally binding requirement that prevailing wages be paid to all workers.

AB 618 Local Agency Public Construction Act: job order contracting: school districts: community college districts

The Senate Education Committee passed AB 618 (Low D) that authorizes a community college district to utilize job order contracting only if the district has entered into a project labor agreement that will apply to all public works that exceed a monetary threshold set by the school district through at least December 31, 2021, regardless of what contracting procedure is used to award that work. It will be heard next in Senate Judiciary where it will be approved.





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

Help for a General with 'concrete' plans to win the bids! Coming back from overseas, this contractor may be 'guilty' by association unless he acts fast. What could be better in a heat wave than a dip in a 'pools' question, and be sure to do more than wave goodbye when your CEO heads out the door...

Q: I currently have an "A" (General Engineering) license in CA. While I know I can do concrete work with my "A" license, sometimes in order to do a foundation or a sidewalk, people want to see that we have the "C-8" (Concrete) classification on our license. How do I go about sitting for the exam and adding it to our license?

A: You will need to complete and submit the Application for Additional Classification. You will be required to show at least four years of full time work experience doing concrete work specifically. With regards to the exam, B&P Code Section 7065.3 allows the CSLB to consider a Waiver of the Trade exam for someone holding a closely related classification, if you can prove that concrete is a significant portion of your General Engineering work. Sweet! Waiver requests however are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and there is no assurance the CSLB will approve the request.

Q: I have been out of the country since last year. I just returned, and I need to make sure that my Contractor's License and corporation are in order. I contacted my Responsible Managing Officer (RMO), who also has his own personal license, and he tells me that he was sued by a large company and lost in relation to his personal license. Is that going to affect my license?

A: It has the potential to affect your license depending on whether he complies with the Judgement or not. If your RMO has an unsatisfied Judgement attached to his license, the CSLB will



suspend any/all licenses he is associated with. I would suggest that you disassociate him from your license to avoid the potential for suspension. Once you disassociate him, you have 90 days to replace him on the license.

Q: I have "B" (General Building) license and I've been doing solar work for a couple years. I want to start a pool pump business. Can I do that with my building license or would I need to get a "C-53" (Swimming Pool) license?

A: General Building contractors are required to be performing at least two unrelated trades on their jobs. In order to start doing projects which only involve pool pumps, you would want to add the "C-61"/ "D-35" (Pool and Spa Maintenance) classification to your license. The "C-53" classification is needed if you are *constructing* pools.

Q: Our CEO recently left the company. Do we need to notify the CSLB?

A: Yes, you will want to notify both the Secretary of State as well as the CSLB of any Officer changes. I looked up your license and your CEO is the only Officer listed on the license so you definitely want, and need, to update it. The Officers you have listed on your license are the only ones with signing authority for the license to make changes, sign renewals, etc.

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

Safety Tip of the Week

HEAVY EQUIPMENT BACKING

Operations involving heavy equipment should always be planned to avoid backing the equipment as much as possible. In many operations, to avoid the awkward backing movement of the equipment is not always economically or environmentally possible. hen the backward movement cannot be eliminated the machine or equipment must be adapted for backing movements.

Many pieces of heavy construction equipment that are wheeled vehicles such as dump trucks, front end loaders, cement trucks, etc. are equipped with special mirrors to help eliminate blind spots. Even with these seeing aids, there are still blind spots from the operator's control position. Blind spot diagrams for each type of construction equipment are available from the manufacturer, showing what an operator can see toward the rear of the machine. Some types of heavy construct ion equipment have no view to the rear at all, and therefore require a guide or spotter to assist the operator in backward movement.

Back-up alarms are installed on most construction equipment. The advantage of the reverse alarm is that any person close to the rear of the equipment is alerted to the forthcoming rearward motion of the machine. This device alone has helped reduce the number of workers being struck by backing equipment.

The real key to preventing equipment backing accidents is the people on the job. That's you and me. Avoid parking vehicles or placing material or equipment in areas where heavy equipment is operating to eliminate obstacles to the machines movement, and STAY ALERT when working nearby.

Operators of heavy equipment, including trucks, should check for obstacles before they begin moving. Be aware of blind areas and never back up unless you are certain the area is clear. Have someone act as a guide in congested areas. Equipment operators, with the cooperation of contractors, workers and the public, can eliminate most, if not all, equipment backing accidents by following the procedures mentioned here and keeping SAFETY foremost in their thoughts.

CHECK YOUR BACK-UP ALARM AT THE START OF EACH SHIFT. IF IT'S BROKEN HAVE YOUR SUPERVISOR ASSIGN A SPOTTER TO YOU.
