

According to David Kalb, founder and former owner of Capitol Services, this was a lively meeting lasting close to 5 hours. The Registrar's Report covered Procedures regarding the Board's Interaction with Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and the CSLB Sunset Review Process.

A welcome report from the Statewide Investigative Fraud Team (SWIFT) on evening the playing field for licensed contractors. Not only did the Board Highlight a number of SWIFT "sting" operations around the State targeting unlicensed individuals, but also detailed how a variety of "bad actors" were put out of business. In one case, a grand jury cracked down on 4 licensees who were involved in a "RMO for hire scheme".

Some interesting facts emerged from the Licensing Division at this Board meeting. 1) There continues to be a significant rejection rate for Limited Liability Company (LLC) applications, primarily due to inconsistencies with the Secretary of State's (SOS) records. Unless the LLC application includes ALL Members and/ or Managers as designated at the SOS, the application will be returned for corrections.

2) Contractors are required to recertify that they're exempt from Worker's Compensation as part of the license renewal process. A number of forms are being rejected because the appropriate box is not being checked. Regardless, one Board member expressed concern that some contractors are being less than truthful when certifying they're in fact exempt from W/C. His example involved concrete contractors who, if honestly exempt, are pouring and finishing their projects with NO employees.



3) The Board adopted a detailed "Table of Acceptable Supporting Experience Documentation" to be used as part of their application review and investigation process.

Several pending bills were discussed and subsequently supported by the Board during the Legislative Program Update. Of note, SB 465 (Hill) which 1) extends the CSLB sunset date from Jan. 1, 2016 to Jan. 1, 2020; 2) eliminates the existing requirement that applicants demonstrate evidence of financial solvency by "possessing" operating capital of \$2,500; and 3) Increases the amount of the contactor's bond from \$12,500 to \$15,000. The \$2,500 requirement has been around for decades and it rarely, if ever, is required to be proven as part of the application/renewal process. If passed and signed by the Governor, SB 561 (Monning) will amend the way in which Home Improvement Salespersons (HIS) can register making it more efficient for both the licensee and salesperson. There was also a lengthy discussion on B&P Code Section 7031, which will be discussed in a future column.

As they do on a yearly basis, the CSLB held a second day of meetings (on June 19) in conjunction with the Nevada State Contractors Board.

Are you covering the cost of your Employee's Individual Medical Policy?

Caution for Individual Policy Reimbursement

The IRS uses a FAQ on Employer Health Care Arrangements to highlight the potential liability for employers that, rather than establishing a group health plan, merely reimburse employees for the cost of their individual health plan premium.

Q1. What are the consequences to the employer if the employer does not establish a health insurance plan for its own employees, but reimburses those employees for premiums they pay for health insurance (either through a qualified health plan in the Marketplace or outside the Marketplace)?

The IRS makes it clear that the consequence is that the employer may face a penalty.

Specifically, as explained in **Notice 2013-54**, employer reimbursement plans are considered to be group health plans and therefore subject to the market reforms, including the prohibition on annual limits for essential health benefits and the requirement to provide certain preventive care without cost sharing. Notice 2013-54 clarifies, however, that employer reimbursement plans cannot be integrated with individual policies to satisfy the market reforms.

Consequently, the employer may be subject to a \$100/day excise tax per applicable employee (which is \$36,500 per year, per employee) under **Code Sec. 4980 D**.

For plan years beginning on and after January 1, 2014, employers should carefully evaluate arrangements under which they reimburse employees for premiums, or are otherwise involved in the purchase of individual health insurance policies that provide non-excepted medical coverage (i.e., coverage that is subject to health care reform's mandates) for employees. These arrangements create significant compliance concerns under health care reform. Furthermore, these individual policies should not be paid for or reimbursed on a pre-tax basis under an employer's cafeteria plan. As described in more detail (left).

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

Safety Tip of the Week

FIRE PREVENTION

This may sound like a contradiction, but the problem with fire prevention on a construction site is the absence of a problem. Fires do not occur with frequency or regularity and therefore workers are not particularly concerned about them. Another word for this is complacency, an environment in which danger grows and thrives. It is extremely difficult to motivate some one to take an active interest in fire prevention when the person has never been involved in a serious fire and when they face other, imminent hazards on a daily basis. This leads to the common misconception that fire prevention is someone else's problem.

Almost every construction worker has at one time or another seen someone injured by a fall or being struck by an object. Very few have seen a person burned in a fire, or seen valuable property and months of work reduced to smoke and ashes.

We need to be reminded regularly of the ever-present danger of fire. We need to know the different types of fires and extinguishers. Briefly, electrical or flammable liquid fires require an extinguisher rated BC. Use a water extinguisher <u>only</u> for Class A fires (wood, paper etc.). A dry chemical extinguisher rated ABC is for all classes of fire. Aim at the base of the fire and move the nozzle from side to side in a sweeping motion. If the fire continues, evacuate everyone from the area and call the fire department.

Observe all 'NO SMOKING' signs, especially near flammables. Make sure the area is free from all combustibles when burning or welding. Place all construction debris in the proper area for disposal. Know where fire extinguishers are located.

A fire today could mean loss of life, loss of a job, personal injury or property damage. Are you doing your part to prevent one? Check both your job and your home for fire hazards.
