



## Final Week for Governor to Act on Bills

As the governor continues to 'pare down' the nearly 800 bills that were sent to him, and recognizing that this Friday at Midnight is his deadline for acting on all bills OR they become law without his signature, a few more he has signed affect contractors and the Contractors State License Board.

**AB 2693 (Dababneh) Chapter # Unavailable – Consumer Protection on PACE Loans** - Strongly supported by the CSLB, this new law creates enhanced consumer protections by requiring a public agency to provide property owners participating in the PACE program with a "Financing Estimate and Disclosure" document. This disclosure will provide much needed information to property owners regarding the financial terms and obligations of the PACE loan. PACE financing is available to property owners in certain cities or counties that have adopted a program. In California, over 400 cities and counties participate in PACE. To qualify, homeowners need to have equity in their home. The homeowner must have no judgment liens or federal or state tax liens. The homeowner cannot be in bankruptcy. The property cannot be subject to a bankruptcy proceeding. The homeowner must not be delinquent on any mortgages. **AB 2859 (Low) Chapter 473 of 2016 Statutes – Retired License Category** - This new law authorizes any of the boards under the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA), including the Contractors State License Board, to establish, through regulations, a system to allow for a retired license category for those licensees who no longer wish to practice their profession or vocation but who do not want their license to become "inactive." A contractor who is currently inactive or active that desires to apply for this category, but must not have any disciplinary actions against their current license. **SB 1479 (Senate Business & Professions Committee) – Chapter Number Unavailable – Blanket Bonds** - Sponsored by the CSLB, this new law will specify that in all home improvement contracts a licensee shall be licensed in this state in an active status for not less than two years prior to submitting an Application for Approval of a Blanket Performance and Payment Bond. Under current law, licensees had to wait 5 years to be able to qualify for a blanket bond. The staff determined there was no valid reason to require a 5-year wait and sponsored legislation to correct it. An 'unlimited' answer in assisting our first contractor has one limitation! The second answer takes a different 'form' as a Qualifier replaces himself. While we take 'time' for one more RMO, we are also always happy to help a contractor's family work through the regulations...

Q: We have a corporation that is licensed with an RMO (Responsible Managing Officer). We want to obtain several new license numbers under different 'dba' (doing business as) names. So same corporation, but with multiple dba's. Is there a limit as to how many licenses we can qualify for under the same entity with the same RMO? Can they be done all at the same time?

A: No, there is no limit to how many licenses an entity can have under different dba names. Keep in mind that in order for the RMO to qualify all the licenses, you must list the exact same personnel on each license.

An individual cannot have multiple applications in process with the CSLB at the same time, so you will be required to apply for each one separately.

Q: I was hired as an RME (Responsible Managing Employee) for my company about 7 years ago and I am now an Officer. We recently received our renewal application which still has me as the RME and I know we need to notify them of the change, but it doesn't seem correct to complete an "Application to Report Change of Corporate Title for Current Officer" of a Corporation, because I'm not technically a "current officer". Should I complete the "Application to Add a New Officer to a Corporation"?

A: Actually you'll need to submit a "Replacing the Qualifying Individual" application. It sounds a bit funny but you are replacing yourself as the RME in order to become the RMO (Responsible Managing Officer).

Q: As an RMO for my company, is there a specified amount of time that I'm required to be on each job location?

A: There is no specified amount of time that a Qualifying Individual is required to be on a specific job site. However, the CSLB does have rules for the amount of time RME's are required to work, however that is not the

case for RMO's. As is the case for all Qualifiers (both RME's and RMO's), the "R" stands for "Responsible". According to rule 823 of the California Code of Regulations, the responsibilities of a Qualifier is to provide direct supervision and control in any one of the following: supervising construction, managing construction activities by making technical and administrative decisions, checking jobs for proper workmanship, or direct supervision on construction job sites.

Q: I've heard of family businesses where a son inherits his father's contractor's license when the father retires. Would this apply for a son-in-law as well? I wasn't sure if the different last name would raise a red flag. Would he be required to take the exams?

A: Yes, in the eyes of the Contractors State License Board, a son-in-law is considered an immediate family member. If your son-in-law has been an employee and actively engaged in your business for at least five years out of the previous seven, then he can request to take over your Sole Owner license and Waive the exams.

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



# Safety Tip of the Week

## HAND SIGNALS FOR CRANE OPERATIONS

The following are the most commonly used hand signals for directing crane lifting operations. Some special operations may require adaptations of these basic signals. When using hand signal be sure the operator can see you and that both of you understand all the signals. You and the operator are in charge of an important operation. Co-workers lives depend on your skills. A wrong signal could cause a serious injury or possible death. THINK SAFETY!

**HOIST** -- Extend the right arm straight out and raise the forearm to vertical, forefinger pointing up, then move hand in small horizontal circle.

**LOWER** -- Extend the right arm downward, forefinger pointing down, then move hand in small horizontal circle.

**RAISE BOOM** -- Extend right arm straight out, fingers closed and thumb pointing upward.

**LOWER BOOM** -- Extend right arm straight out, fingers closed and thumb pointing downward.

**SWING** -- Extend right arm away from body, point with finger in direction of swing of boom.

**STOP** -- Right arm extended down with wrist bent and palm down and open.

**EMERGENCY STOP** -- Right arm extended, palm down, then move hand rapidly right and left.

**TRAVEL** -- (both tracks, crawler cranes only) Use both fists in front of body, making a circular motion about each other to indicate the direction of travel - forward or backward.

**DOG EVERYTHING** -- Clasp hands in front of the body.

**RAISE BOOM & LOWER LOAD** -- Extend right arm with thumb pointing up, then flex fingers in and out as long as load movement is desired.

**LOWER BOOM & RAISE LOAD** -- Extend right arm with thumb pointing down, then flex fingers in and out as long as load movement is desired.

As for the rest of us on the job, stay alert when working near any crane operation. Avoid working under a moving load -- stay clear of the counter balance -- and always remember that the crane operator's vision may be obscured; be on guard for your own safety.

**KEEP ALL PARTS OF A CRANE, FALL LINES, HOOK, BLOCK, AND LOAD A MINIMUM OF 15 FEET FROM ALL ELECTRICAL LINES.**
