MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY CLOSURE

FEBRUARY - OCTOBER 2017

Access to the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) will be limited during construction and installation of new equipment. Customers will be accommodated in the MRF when possible or redirected to other areas.

To maximize recycling, designated areas will be available to customers at the MRF for the following separated materials:

- Asphalt
- Concrete
- Drywall
- Metal
- Wood
- Yard Trimmings

For customers who require a guaranteed minimum 65% recycling level on their mixed load of construction and demolition material*, the MRWMD will transfer these loads to a San Jose processor. The cost for this service is \$90 per ton. An extra Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) point will be given to projects using this facility.

For information on the MRF closure, weekly updates will be available at www.mrwmd.org and at the Scale House. For guidelines on proper material separation and a complete list of fees, please refer to the MRWMD Disposal Fees brochure available at the Scales and on the website.

Class B. This Type II New Juvenile Hall Project will replace the original late 1950's facility. The new facility will be constructed in phases with existing buildings being demolished to make way for the new recreation yard and support buildings. Upon completion, the facility will provide approximately 63,438 square feet (sf) of total building area and approximately 100,108 sf of site improvements on 9.217± acres of the greater 38.407± acres of county owned land in Salinas. The completed 120-bed facility will be laid out in a campus style design with a central 1-1/4 acre recreation yard surrounded by four housing buildings and support buildings. Two new 30-bed medium security housing buildings will be approximately 7,176 sf with single and double rooms, and the new 30-bed high-security housing building will be approximately 9,715 sf with single and double rooms. Each new housing building will have three 10-bed housing units with connecting dayroom and showers surrounding a central multi-purpose room, staff-support spaces, and an outdoor recreation area. Additionally, the high-security housing building will provide on-unit classrooms and a satellite medical exam room. The base project includes the renovation of the existing 4,775 sf medium-security dormitory housing building; the renovation includes the remodel two existing housing units, one with 10 beds and one with 20 beds, with existing day room and programming space retained. Program services space will be provided at each housing building for education; religious services; counseling; substance abuse classes; group counseling; mental health evaluations; and, other programs to reduce recidivism. The new administration building provides spaces for contact and non-contact visitation; central control; medical facilities; staff offices; intake processing; release; staff training; staff locker rooms; staff break room; equipment storage; and, maintenance shop with direct access to the new juvenile hall campus. The project provides a new central kitchen, dining, laundry and warehouse building, and a school/gymnasium building with a teacher resource room, educational offices and staff support areas directly off a large recreational yard. Primary security and visual supervision for the new facility will be provided by the new central control room, which will utilize closed circuit television to provide visual control and assist in the control of the security perimeter fence line. Central control will have visual supervision of the housing units, attached outdoor exercise areas, and program spaces. Each new and existing housing unit will also be monitored by a smaller unit security station, located off the multi-purpose room.

While change can be a pain our first contractor finds some relief in my answer. The possible 'suspense' is causing another contractor to watch the clock and worry if he can go to work before his time runs out...

Q: I am a licensed "C-45" (Electrical Sign) Contractor and I am going to be retiring soon, selling my business, and backing out completely. I want to make the transition as painless as possible and I'm hoping you can help me with the process. The prospective buyer does not have the experience to Qualify for the license, however I have an employee who recently obtained his "C-45" Sole Proprietor license and he is willing to be the RME (Responsible Managing Employee) for the license. What is the process to make the necessary changes to the license?

A: The process will vary depending on whether you are doing a Stock sale or an Asset sale. With a Stock sale the buyer can keep the existing license number and make the appropriate changes to the existing license. He would submit his Application to Replace the Qualifier to add your "C-45" employee to the license as an RME. Be aware that as an RME, the employee would be required to Inactivate his Sole Proprietor license. The buyer would also need to file the forms to update the Officers to remove you (and anyone else who is no longer going to be associated with the business) and add himself as an Officer.

With an asset sale, the buyer would be required to form a new entity and file for a new License number.

Q: I recently obtained my "C-22" (Asbestos Abatement) Contractor's License. One of the requirements was that I show proof that I was in process of registering with DOSH, which I did. I haven't completed the registration process yet. Is there a specific time-period I have in completing this process? Am I able to legally work now that the license is issued?

A: The CSLB will issue a "C-22" license provided that you show you are in process of registering with DOSH, however you are not permitted to perform any Asbestos abatement work until you submit proof to the CSLB of your completed DOSH registration. The CSLB allows you 90 days from the time your license is issued to submit proof of registration. If you do not submit proof within 90 days, your license will be Suspended.

Q: We have a Joint Venture (JV) license made up of three entities that we obtained for a large project which was completed at the end of last year. We have another opportunity to bid on a large project due to start early next year. Are we required to get a new Contractor's License? We are unclear as to whether Joint Venture licenses are for single project purposes or if you are permitted to perform multiple jobs with the same JV License.

A: Licensed Joint Ventures are permitted to perform multiple projects in the State of California.

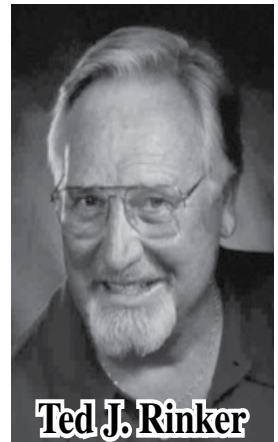

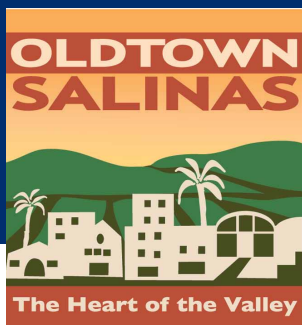

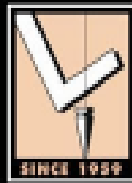

Safety Tip of the Week

HEAVY EQUIPMENT BACKING

Operations involving heavy equipment should always be planned to avoid backing the equipment as much as possible. In many operations, to avoid the awkward backing movement of the equipment is not always economically or environmentally possible. When the backward movement cannot be eliminated the machine or equipment must be adapted for backing movements.

Many pieces of heavy construction equipment that are wheeled vehicles such as dump trucks, front end loaders, cement trucks, etc. are equipped with special mirrors to help eliminate blind spots. Even with these seeing aids, there are still blind spots from the operator's control position. Blind spot diagrams for each type of construction equipment are available from the manufacturer, showing what an operator can see toward the rear of the machine. Some types of heavy construction equipment have no view to the rear at all, and therefore require a guide or spotter to assist the operator in backward movement.

Back-up alarms are installed on most construction equipment. The advantage of the reverse alarm is that any person close to the rear of the equipment is alerted to the forthcoming rearward motion of the machine. This device alone has helped reduce the number of workers being struck by backing equipment.

The real key to preventing equipment backing accidents is the people on the job. That's you and me. Avoid parking vehicles or placing material or equipment in areas where heavy equipment is operating to eliminate obstacles to the machine's movement, and **STAY ALERT** when working nearby.

Operators of heavy equipment, including trucks, should check for obstacles before they begin moving. Be aware of blind areas and never back up unless you are certain the area is clear. Have someone act as a guide in congested areas. Equipment operators, with the cooperation of contractors, workers and the public, can eliminate most, if not all, equipment backing accidents by following the procedures mentioned here and keeping **SAFETY** foremost in their thoughts.

CHECK YOUR BACK-UP ALARM AT THE START OF EACH SHIFT. IF IT'S BROKEN HAVE YOUR SUPERVISOR ASSIGN A SPOTTER TO YOU.
